**Proposed Project Location:** Trumbull's Corners Rd (Rte. 133) and Enfield Falls Rd (Rte. 327), Ithaca, NY

**Issue to be addressed:**

Sediment transport and bank erosion would be addressed.

**Proposed Project or Action** Stream bank stabilization and in-stream stabilization. A stream bank stabilization project has occurred downstream of this site and the structures installed downstream have been filling up with sediment due to this upstream bank erosion.
